 - 3/4 Minimum English and Reading score 65%
 - 3/4 1st, 2nd or 3rd attempt only, any version
- x Personal Statement a fewshort answer questions

OPTIONACRITERIA

- x Health or CommunityRelated Experience (paid or unpaid)— within 3 years of application, 75 hrsninimum
- x Language Proficiencyspeaking and reading proficiency in English and one other language.
- **The following conditions apply to the GPA:
- 1. A GPA of at least 3.00 in booth the following:
 - 9 ALL prerequisite courses coined AND
 - 9 Just the FOUR SCIENCE prerequisites
- 2. Must have a minimum grade of C or better in all prerequisites. A grade of G too low
