# Transportation Survey

Annual transportation survey distributed to student/staff/faculty to assess emissions from commuting

Survey distributed to a random sample of:

- ~3000 students (180 responses)
- ~250 staff (142 responses)
- ~250 faculty (121 responses)

Survey also distributed by tabling

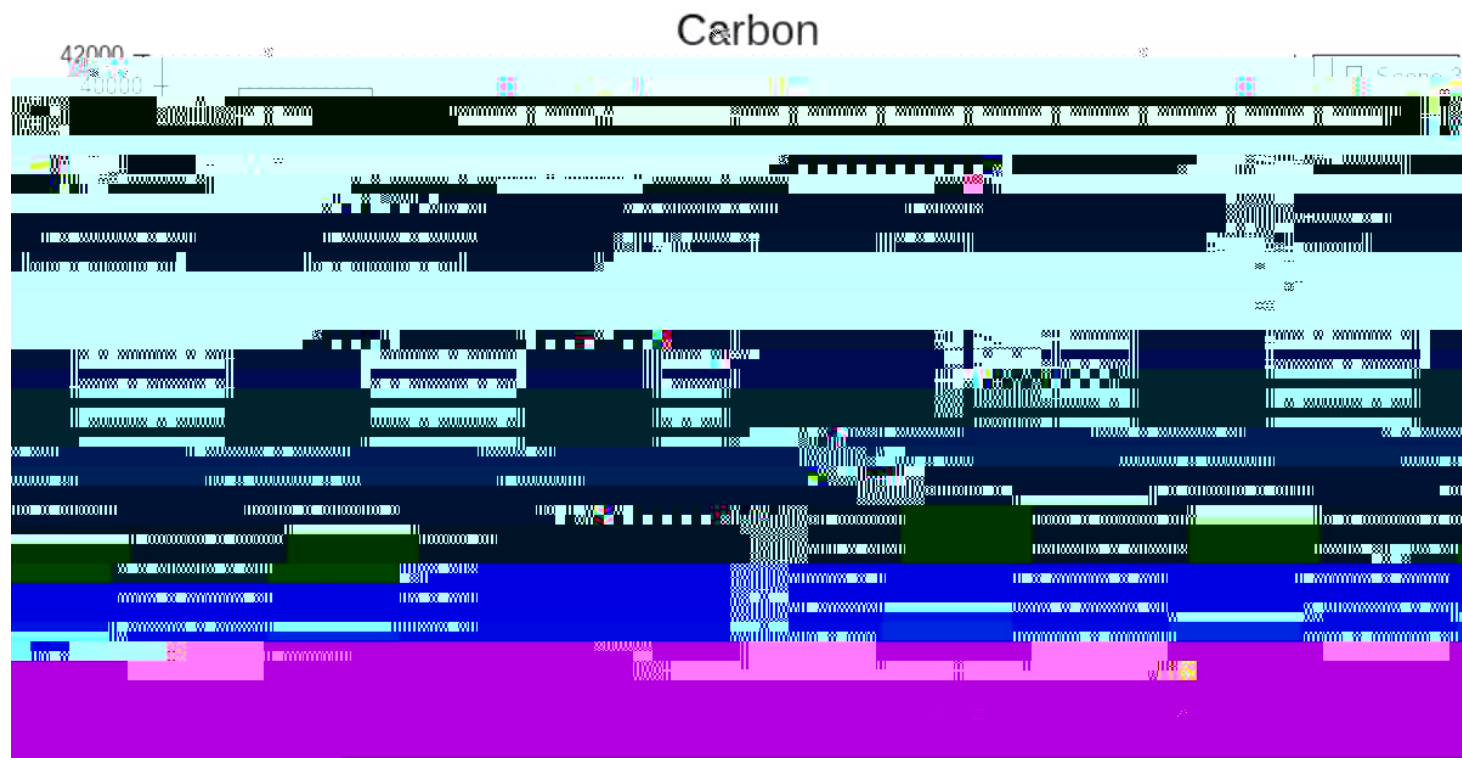

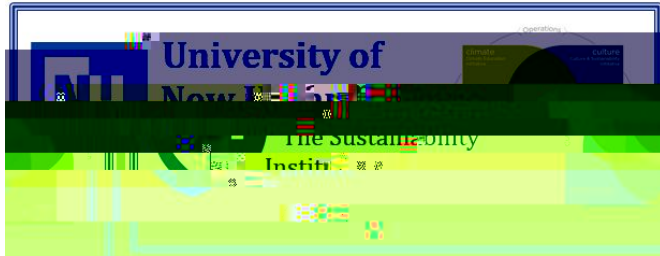


# GHG Inventory in the Future

Data retrieval process will change based on understanding of SiMAP

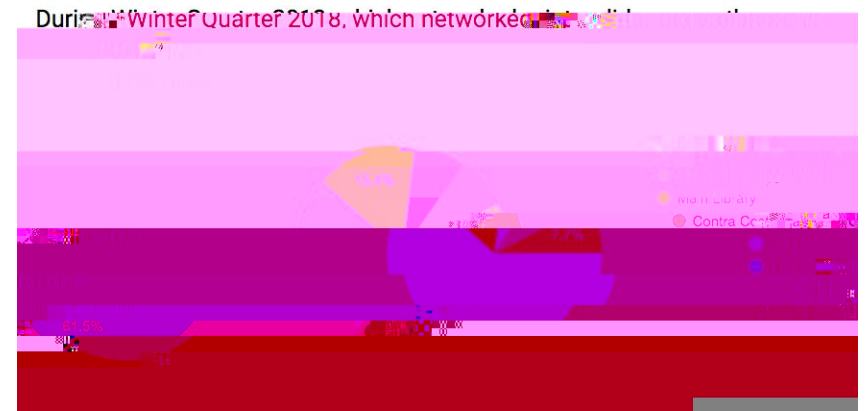
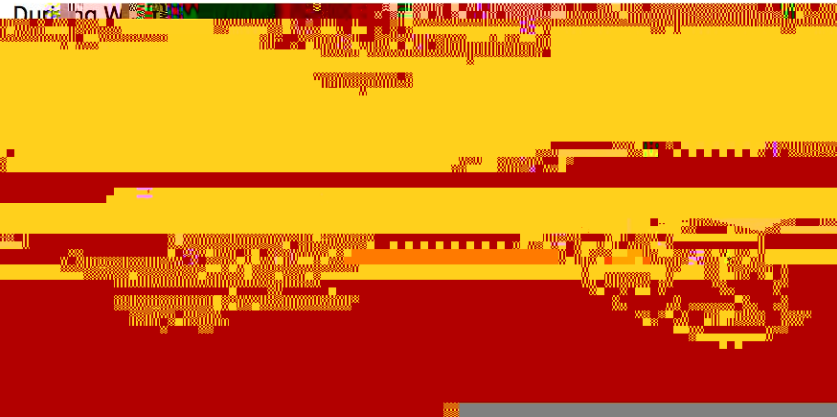
